With reference to your letter Registration No.-UGCOM/R/2015/60374 dated 30.01.2015 received in this office on 02.02.2015 on the above subject, I am to inform you as under: -

1.	<p>Sunrise University, Bagad Rajput, Tech. Ramgarh, Alwar, Rajasthan has been established by an Act of State Legislature of Rajasthan as a Private University and is empowered to award degrees as specified under Section 22 of the UGC Act through its main campus at regular mode with the approval of Statutory Bodies/Councils, wherever its required.</p> <p>Sunrise University is not authorized to open study centre/ off campus centre beyond the territorial jurisdiction of the state as per the judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in case of Prof. Yashpal Vs. State of Chhattisgarh. The University can not open its centre(s) even within the state as per the provision of UGC (Establishment of and Maintenance of Standards in Private Universities) Regulations, 2003 without the approval of UGC.</p> <p>The UGC has not granted any approval to the University to open off campus/study centre.</p> <p>For information related to Distance Education you are requested to approach directly to the Distance Education Bureau of UGC, Distance Education Council Building, Indira Gandhi National Open University, Maidan Garhi, Delhi.</p>
2.	<p>All the directors <i>directors</i> issued by Hon'ble Apex Court are taken into consideration.</p>
3.	<p>All though approval of All India Council Technical Education is not required for Universities to conduct Engineering courses under regular mode, the Universities have to maintain the norms and standards of All India Council Technical Education.</p>
